Scale Olympics is held every other year. Students set goals in up to nine technical events: scales, cadences, arpeggios, triads, sight-reading, transposing, harmonization, ear training and theory. Students ‘compete’ only against themselves, and can participate in as many events as they wish. For each event they will receive a Blue Ribbon (1st Place, showing mastery of that event), a Red Ribbon (2nd Place), or a White Ribbon (3rd Place). Top honors for mastery in all nine events are the Blue and Yellow Rosettes.

Guild establishes definitive goals for students of all ages and levels. Students demonstrate they have achieved their goals by playing their program for an outside adjudicator. They receive a written evaluation based on their age and length of study, a certificate and a pin. This very flexible event allows for different program sizes including Local (2-3 pieces), District (4-6), State (7-9) and National (10). Guild takes place every May.

COMING UP – PIANORAMA 2017

Pianorama is a multi-piano duet ensemble event held every other year. To participate, students must first pass a live audition and then attend three rehearsals before the concerts are held. Students gain ensemble experience, and learn how to follow a conductor. There are nine groups from 2nd year beginner to advanced. Pianorama 2017 will take place this coming October and November.
